

T rue learning, I believe, is learning something to the point at which it becomes second nature. Reading and math are good academic examples. Normally, we can read without thinking of how to sound out letters. Most of us know the multiplication tables without thinking. This applies to all areas of life.

Shouldn't our goal be to instill God's Word into our children, the way God instills the nurturing or protecting instinct into parents? Can we teach them, by word and deed, to the point that they would recognize evil—without thinking—and automatically turn away? Can we teach our precious ones to respond—automatically—in kindness to an unkind deed? Yes, we can.

PRIORITY: GOD'S WORD

If I could give only one piece of advice to a new home schooler, it would be this:

Do not get so wrapped up in academics that you leave out the most important thing. The Bible is the only book in which true wisdom is found. Teaching your children to apply God's truth will teach them to discern what's right or wrong, true or false, loving or cruel, profitable or foolish, noble or cowardly. Start every morning in God's Word! If you start with other subjects, Bible easily gets pushed out of the way.

Remember the saying that goes something like this: "Give a man a fish and you've fed him for a day, but teach a man to fish and you've fed him for life." The greatest gift you will ever give your child will be to teach him to develop the habit of purposefully reading, studying, and applying God's Word daily. It will affect every area of his life, every day of his life.

Don't believe that Bible study is not a legitimate subject—it is! the Bible is great literature, with many literary forms and devices—poetry, prose, allegory, epic, parable, history, even humor. The Bible is also regarded as a collection of materials for research into ancient history and culture. The books of the Old and New Testaments, are treated by many historians, in the same way as any other documents used for research into the history, religion, and culture of the ancient world. Old Testament scholarship is part of the study of the ancient Near East, and New Testament scholarship is part of the study of Graeco-Roman civilization.

Bible reading should be the highest priority in your child's studies. Students study literary forms and cultural background in the books of the Bible and apply the messages to their lives, to their relationships, and to the world. The Bible is the perfect

J. I. Packard writes in the book *Knowing God*:

A study of the nature and character of God is the most practical project anyone can engage in. Knowing about God is crucially important for the living of our lives....We are cruel to ourselves if we try to live in the world without knowing about the God whose world it is and who runs it. The world becomes a strange, mad, painful place, and life disappointing and unpleasant business for those who do not know about God. Disregard the study of God and you sentence yourself to stumble and blunder through life blindfolded, as it were, with no sense of direction and no understanding of what surrounds you. This way you can waste your life and lose your soul.

USING THE CHECK LIST

The Check List in this chapter is based on reading the Bible through in one year, reading between thirty minutes to an hour (the amount of time for most television programs), five days a week. You may use the Check List according to the selected daily schedule, or ignore the suggested schedule and use your own. Both the verses and their corresponding *The Narrated Bible* page numbers are included in the Check List. (A Check List for seven daily readings is included in the back of *The Narrated Bible*.)

Please realize that this plan is only one option. Bible study is not measured in the number of verses we cover at one time, nor in the number of insights we are able to glean from one verse. Rather, the Bible is where we meet God to hear His Word. God opens our understanding when He sees fit. As always, God is in control. He knows the best time to reveal truth to us each individually.

You need to read the Bible at a pace you feel comfortable with. Our goal is to read through the Bible to get the whole picture. There’s nothing special about the one-year (or 52-week) time frame. You can read through the Bible in two years or longer. This program is just a framework to get you started. Rely on the Holy Spirit to guide you through the readings. The most important thing for us to remember is not to focus upon the quantity of information we learn but to remain faithful to whatever spiritual truth God has entrusted to our care.

The previous chapter explains how the daily Bible readings can also be used to teach or reinforce language arts skills.
