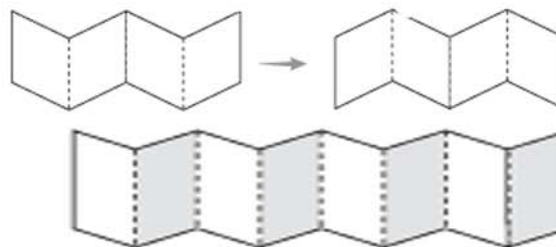


# Noah's Ark Accordion Booklet

4. Assemble as shown below.



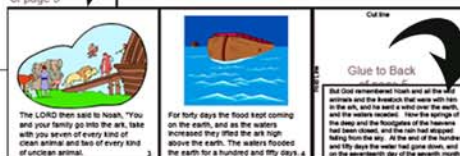
## Assembling the Accordion Booklet



1. Glue cover to back of page 1



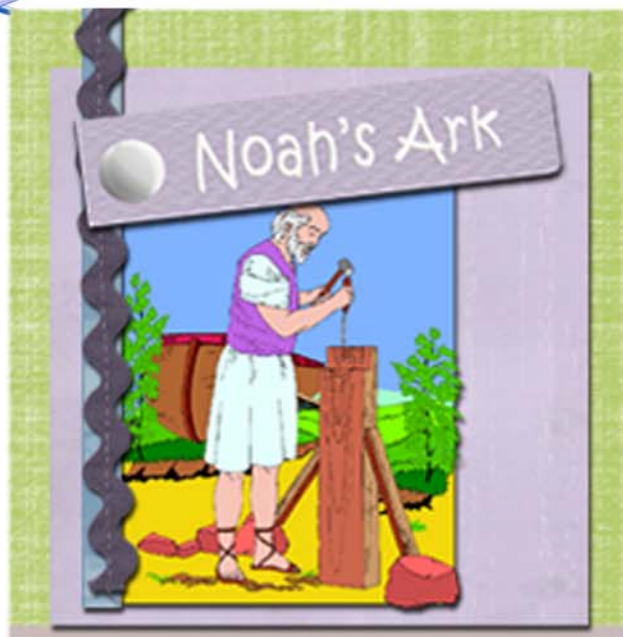
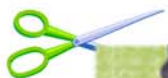
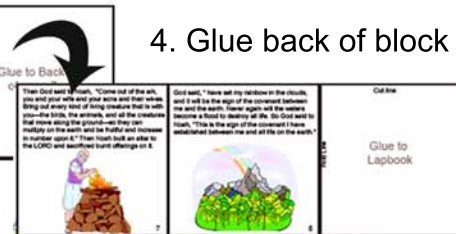
2. Glue back of block 3 to back of page 3

Booklet Cover

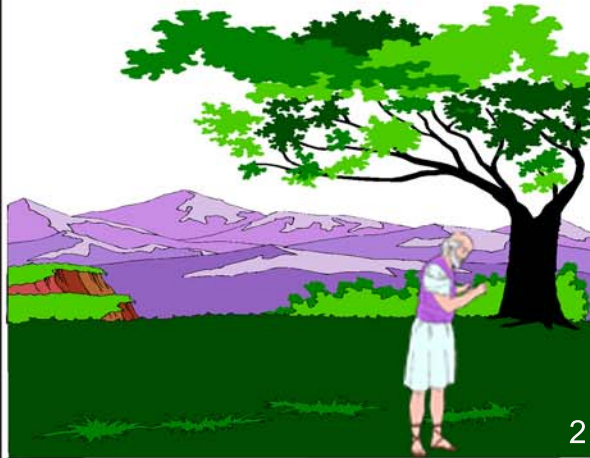


5. Glue assembled booklet into Genesis lapbook.

Glue to Back of page 5

Trim away edges then cut page in half lengthwise (see scissors). You will have two strips with three blocks each.

But God remembered Noah and all the wild animals and the livestock that were with him in the ark, and he sent a wind over the earth, and the waters receded. Now the springs of the deep and the floodgates of the heavens had been closed, and the rain had stopped falling from the sky. At the end of the hundred and fifty days the water had gone down, and on the seventeenth day of the seventh month the ark came to rest on the mountains of Ararat.

Glue to Back of page 7

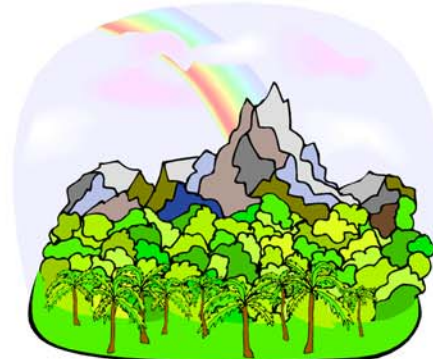

Glue to Lapbook

Cut line

Trim away edges then cut page in half lengthwise (see scissors). You will have two strips with three blocks each.
